Developer CORNER

2022 was a very active year in Union Park. 700 new lots were completed bringing the total number of homesites in all of Union Park to close to 3,000. 450 new homes were sold in 2022 with over 2,300 sales from inception! Drees Homes, Coventry Homes, and Highland Homes are nearing buildout. Tri Pointe Homes opened their models and are building their first homes in Union Park. Union Park Boulevard was completed to be four lanes from FM 1385 to Highway 380. Starbucks opened, Einstein Bagel and Qdoba had their construction plans approved by the Town of Little Elm, and Slim Chicken's closed on their site next to Starbucks. Union House, the multi-family community developed by Hillwood, was completed and is almost fully leased. The growth of Union Park has been exceptional. It is wonderful to see so many families out in the parks and on the trails when driving through the community in the evenings and on weekends.
